11 new one-bed apartments in Littlegate Street will soon be released for sale off-plan by Thomas Homes. The new Hall will be on two floors and provide over 145 sq m of space for various community activities such as Mother and Baby Groups, Pensioners meetings and Youth Groups. The members of St Aldate's have been totally involved in the design of the community facilities and are looking forward to using this much needed space.
