NEW APARTMENTS ON KENDRICK ROAD IN READING

Local developer Thomas Homes has started work on the redevelopment of the former Mansfield Hall buildings on the corner of Kendrick Road and London Road in Reading. Mansfield Hall closed several years ago and the two existing white stucco Victorian buildings will now be converted into twelve 2-bedroom and two 1-bedroom apartments.

The apartments will all be extremely spacious, ranging in size from approximately 550 ft² to 1,000 ft², with high ceilings and large sash windows, and benefit from allocated off street parking in communal landscaped gardens. The Victorian buildings are impressive with many period features, and will offer stylish and unique new homes.
