North Swindon MP, Justin Tomlinson, launches Priam House, Heritage Plaza

A major regeneration project, Heritage Plaza is in the heart of the town's heritage district which consists of the National Trust, English Heritage, STEAM Museum, Designer Outlet Centre and the proposed new British Postal Museum.

Comprising of five brand new residential blocks which will be released in phases and will consist of 124 apartments, the first phase, Priam House, contains 34 high specification one and two bedroom apartments, priced from £109,000, arranged over three floors which will overlook a vibrant pedestrianised square. The remaining four blocks - King House, Rokeby House, Garrett House and Cardean House – will be situated next to Priam House and will form an open air courtyard to the first floor with secure semi-covered parking below.

Justin Tomlinson MP (North Swindon) said, "I'm delighted to help launch this important development at the heart of Swindon's historic quarter. Heritage Plaza is an important part of the regeneration and preservation of this area, so I look forward to the project reaching completion. This is a vital part of Swindon's history and I'm sure it will become an exciting part of the town's future."
