### **REDEVELOPMENT OF KINGSBURY HILL HOUSE SCHOOL IN MARLBOROUGH**

Local developer Thomas Homes has started work on the redevelopment of the former Kingsbury Hill House School in Marlborough. The school closed several years ago and the former owner received planning consent for 12 houses for the over 55's which Thomas Homes are now implementing.

The houses range in size from approximately 1,200 to 2,000 sq ft and have flexible accommodation with three or four bedrooms, and some with an additional sun room.
